

**ST. LIBORY CONSOLIDATED SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 30 PTC

Old Business:

- Amber, was able to get a yard sign for the school yard for 8th Graduation. ‘Rock Your Block’ was booked, but she was able to secure a sign from another company.
- Amber is working with Scholastic Book Clubs to have the Book Fair back. The school did not have a book fair in 2020 due to COVID-19. Plan was to schedule it on Friday, September 3rd. The date has now changed to Friday, September 10th and will coincide with Grandparents Day.
- Amber and Julie had discussed having a Food Truck the day of the Village Wide Yard Sale. The stipulation would be the Food Truck would need to donate a percentage of sales to the PTC and could not sell drinks. The PTC will sell the drinks. Julie reached out to 20 different food trucks. Some were already booked and others never returned her message. Jennifer said maybe we can see if we can book a truck for the Fall. Julie will see what she can do.

New Business:

- Last Day of School & Fun Day was a hit! Good job Mrs. Hudson, Teachers and volunteers! Fun Day was to be held on May 18th (Tuesday of the last week of school), but it rained. They switched the events of the official last day of school

and Fun Day. Kona Ice (Shaved Ice Truck) came to the school on May 18th. Fun Day with a water theme was held on the last day of school, May 20th.

- Julie spoke to Mr. Range with Braeutigam Orchards. He said they would love to help do another Pie Fundraiser with the PTC. She mentioned that we would have a smaller selection of pies vs. the selection in 2019. He was good with that. It was decided to this fundraiser in November 2021, so those ordering could have their pies for Thanksgiving.
- Mrs. Diecker is going to check with Mrs. Bultman to see if it is doable to have the Cardinal Calendar Fundraiser the same time as the pie fundraiser.
- Amber mentioned selling Peel Pizza's in the Fall of 2021 as PTC Fundraiser. The PTC would make 30% of sales. Pizza's range in price \$14 - \$16. It was decided tonight to have the Peel Pizza Fundraiser in February 2022.
- At this time, the plan is to have the Cusamano's Produce Box Fundraiser in April 2022.
